Questions for personal meditation and study

1. Why do you think it's important to not only teach what we believe but also what we don't believe? Or is it important?
2. Review the history of the starting of the Galatian churches in Acts 13:48-49; 14:1; 14:21-22. When hearing that his churches are following a false gospel, given this history, why is Paul so astonished?
3. Review John 6:44-45. How did we become Christians in the first place? When we were taught who was doing the teaching? What is the result in the life of the one taught by God according to these verses? See the word "called" in Galatians 1:6. How do these relate?
4. Look at Deuteronomy 7:6-8. Why did God chose Israel? Why did He choose you? Why do you think people have a problem believing that God chose them rather than believing that they chose God?
5. What kinds of things do Christians today add to the gospel, teaching that those things must be done if a person is going to be a true Christian, or receive the true blessing of God?
6. What do you think about the formula, Jesus plus nothing equals everything?
7. So if God gives us salvation freely entirely by grace, why would I seek to be moral or share my faith or do anything else that we might think a Christian should do or be?
