Questions for personal meditation and study

1. Discuss the meaning of “conceited” from Galatians 5:26. Look up the word “vainglorious.”
2. What kinds of behaviors would you put in the category of “conceited” “vainglorious” driven by “honor-hunger?”
3. How are these related to verse 25, “walking in the Spirit?”
4. Galatians 5:24 says that when we belong to Christ we have crucified the flesh. How does “belonging to Christ” affect our identity and worth? See 1Peter 2:9-10.
5. How is being conceited or driven by “honor-hunger” contrary to who we are in Christ; inconsistent with our true worth?
6. What are we tempted with when we try to restore a brother or sister who may be caught up in a sinful pattern of behavior? See verse 6:1-2.
7. How do we “bear one another’s burdens?” Give examples from your Christian life.
8. How does “honor-hunger” impede our bearing each other’s burdens?
