## Questions for personal meditation and study

1. Read Galatians 6:6. Do you think Pastors should be paid? How would you arrive at a salary for Pastors? How is it the same and how is it different from other jobs? Consider the word “share” (KOINONEO) in verse 6.
2. Read Galatians 6:7-8. How is God mocked? How are believers deceived? What does that have to do with “reaping and sowing?”
3. How is the idea that I can and should live according to my own design rather than God’s design; what does this have to do with God being mocked? How is it the same as expecting a banana harvest from the planting of apple seeds?
4. How do we sow to please the Spirit and what does that have to do with the gospel?
5. How does the gospel lead us to verses 9 and 10?
6. What do people typically boast about? How does that relate to what a person loves? What / Who do you love most?
7. Why is the cross an offense to many people?
8. Why does Paul “boast in the cross?”
9. What does Paul mean when he says that he is dead to the world and the world is dead to him? What does that teach us with regard to our relationship with the world?
