For discussion in small groups and personal reflection:

1. How do we usually determine the value of a thing? Why is gold valuable while common sand isn't?
2. Considering who God is and what He has done, how does He rate on our scale of what is valuable?
3. Thumb through the first few chapters of Hebrews. List as many attributes and actions of Jesus that contribute to His value and rarity?
4. What does value have to do with punishment? Why is the punishment for murder more severe than the punishment for speeding in your car?
5. What "crime" is committed when we sin? Who is the crime committed against? What punishment must there be for sin?
6. Read verses 32-39. From what's there, how would you define perseverance or endurance in the faith? Is it a holding onto a set of beliefs? What is the Hebrew's original audience being called to do? What might be the equivalent in our lives today?
7. How does this section help Christians to persevere?
